It's hard to believe that it's June again, and we are saying farewell to another group of talented, lively, community minded individuals. In September, we can barely get our heads around all that has to happen in the following 10 months in order to make this day possible, but then, as if by magic—it gets done!—and the day arrives. And we face it with hope for the future and nostalgia for the past.

But the truth is—it's not magic. What gets done in the senior year between September and June is the product of plain old hard work and determination. Not only does the work of school continue for the graduating senior—it's amplified by the work involved in figuring out post-high school plans, and all the organization and design involved in the celebratory milestones of the year. Class of 2022: you have arrived at the final crest, prepared to ride the wave into the future.

Without a doubt, Rye Neck's Class of 2022 has left an indelible impression on the school and community. It boasts 61 members of National Honor Society, 10 AP Scholars

with Distinction, 7 AP Scholars with Honor and 9 AP Scholars. It also numbers among its students 5 National Merit Commended Students and 3 National Merit Finalists. On the athletic fields, 62 seniors participated in sports, and Rye Neck's teams made countless appearances in sectional and league championship competition. On the stage, our students came back inside and mounted two successful productions this year. The Student Internship Program (SIP) was up and running and over 100 strong this year! And collectively, the Class of 2022 has accumulated more than 12,500 hours of community service and earned more than \$37,000 in scholarship awards—and counting!

Rye Neck's Class of 2022 is composed of 108 unique, energetic and hard-working individuals. Perhaps because their high school experience was so interrupted, the enthusiasm they displayed for their class, for their teams, for their activities—for just being here—leaves an imprint on all who had the good fortune to work with them. If nothing else, when school returned in full, what these students

seemed to cherish above all else was the ability just to be with each other—and to make those moments together count. These are the students who played chess at the lounge, who helped each other with homework and projects, who competed in the Wordle, who shared stories and snacks and everything else you come across in a day. This is the class that got things done together—and for that incredible attribute, they will always be remembered.

In fact, in the weeks since they left for their internships, the halls seemed eerily quiet without that energy that so defines this group. And while we all are adjusting to this change, what we are confident in is the exuberance with which this group will take on the challenges that face them in this next phase of life—and beyond. Nothing halted the progress—or the hope and enthusiasm—of Rye Neck's Class of 2022. And I daresay, nothing will.
