

APRIL(cont.)

- SIP Program begins week of April 15th.
- April 19th - Review 3rd Q report cards and graduation requirements. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- Apply for all local scholarships for which you qualify.

MAY

- May 1st—National College Deadline Day—deposit at one college/university.
- May 6th- May 17th - AP Exams for those students taking AP courses.
- May 24th—Review final progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- **Inform the School Counseling Office of your final post high school plans.**
- Send thank you notes to those who helped with your college application.

JUNE

- June 4, 14, 18, 20, 21, 24 and 25 –Regents/ final exams.
- **June 24, 2024 - Graduation**
June 25, 2024- Graduation Rain date

CONGRATULATIONS!

- Final report cards posted—TBD.

JULY/AUGUST

- By July 1st counselors send final transcript to the school you are attending.
- Rye Neck email will be deactivated—transfer documents now.
- In you enrolled in a college or AP course while in high school, send your college transcript directly from that college or request AP scores to be send on CollegeBoard wesbsite.

CHECKLIST FOR SENIORS/PARENTS

AUGUST:

- Roll over and update your Common Application, start activities section.
- August 4th- **Deadline** to register for the September 9th ACT.
- Work on college essay(s).
- August 21st- Tryouts begin for the 2023 fall sports season for all Varsity and JV sports (9-12th grades). Register on line with Family ID.
- Review course schedule—keep in mind this is a critical part of your college application.

SEPTEMBER

- If you have not already done so, return signed transcript release form, student personal data sheet, parent questionnaire and updated resume to the School Counseling Office **ASAP**.
- See your counselor to discuss post high school plans and/or finalize college list with your counselor.
- September 7th - **High School Open House**
- September 8th- **Deadline** to register for the October 7th SAT.
- September 9th - ACT test
- September 22nd - **Deadline** to register for the October 28th ACT.
- **September 28th** - Mandatory **Senior College Application Meeting** in the Performing Arts Center at 7:00 p.m. **YOU MUST ATTEND THIS MEETING!**
- October 2nd - Last day to add a class.

SEPTEMBER (cont.)

- Remind teachers to prepare letters of recommendation and give them your application deadline(s).
- Call colleges to set up interviews if recommended or required.
- Plan your college visits early, fall appointments fill quickly.
- Note College applications deadlines: Early Decision/Early Action candidates should be working on their applications - check deadlines carefully.
- Request transcripts through Naviance.
- For scholarship information see Mrs. Kane.
- Check Naviance website for schedule of college representative visits.

OCTOBER

- Starting October 1st—File CSS Financial Aid PROFILE online at www.collegeboard.com if required by the colleges you applied to.
- October 6th - **Deadline** to register for the November 4th SAT.
- October 7th - SAT.
- October 13th - Review 1st progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- October 28th- ACT Test.
- Early Decision, Early Action or Rolling Admissions: get forms to your counselor and teachers at least two weeks before application deadlines.
- Request transcripts through Naviance.
- Continue visits with college representatives in the School Counseling Office.
- Begin Senior Internship Program search in Social Studies classes.
- December 2nd SAT.

NOVEMBER

- November 3rd - **Deadline** to register for the
- November 3rd - **Deadline** to register for the December 9th ACT.
- November 4th - SAT.
- November 10th – Last day to drop a class.
- November 17th - Review 1st Q report card. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- **Attend College Financial Aid** workshop 6:00 pm in the PAC. Parents and students are welcome - TBD.
- Notify counselor if any colleges require 1st Q grades.
- Consult with your counselor regarding post high school plans if you have not already done so.
- Continue visits with college representatives in the School Counseling Office.
- **Reminder!** File CSS Financial Aid PROFILE online at www.collegeboard.com if required by the colleges you applied to.
- Apply for scholarships.
- Apply to schools with regular deadlines.
- Sign up for winter sports.

DECEMBER

- Submit FAFSA financial aid application date TBD.
- December 1st - All SUNY and CUNY applications should be completed.
- Request transcripts through Naviance.
- December 2nd - SAT.
- December 9th - ACT Test.
- Check the status of early apps on college portal.
- December 22nd- Review second quarter progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.

DECEMBER (cont.)

- Apply for scholarships.

JANUARY

- Students should attend review sessions for mid-term/Regents exams offered by teachers.
- January 24th-27th - Mid-term exams.
- Apply for scholarships. See Mrs. Kane
- Complete community service ASAP and hand in hours to Mrs. Kane.
- Submit FAFSA if you did not already do so.

FEBRUARY

- February 2nd- Review 2nd Q report cards. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- Counselors submit mid-year transcripts to colleges.
- Apply for all local scholarships for which you qualify.

MARCH

- March 15th - Review 3rd Q progress report. Any questions or concerns, call teachers/counselor.
- Apply for summer jobs/internships.
- Apply for all local scholarships for which you qualify.
- Sign up for spring sports.

APRIL

- Inform your counselor of college decisions.
- Compare financial aid award letters
- Make sure you notify the college and the School Counseling Office of the college you decide to attend. Deposit at **ONE** college only—**deadline: May 1st**.
